Worship

Your kids are welcome in worship! We love having kids of all ages in worship. Choose the option that fits you best: Have them with you in the Sanctuary, step out to the Wiggle Room or take them to the Nursery.

Wiggle Room

During worship, the Narthex-the space just outside of the Sanctuarybecomes the Wiggle Room. It is a space where families can enjoy the service while your children have a bit of "wiggle room" to explore and play quietly. Books and toys will be available during the service for children to utilize. The Wiggle Room opens during the first hymn of worship and closes during the last hymn. The Wiggle Room is welcome to all ages.

Nursery Care

While children are always welcome in worship, childcare is provided for children from birth through preschool in our Nursery, room 204. We seek to nurture our littlest ones and empower parents from the get-go. **Our Nursery is staffed by trained and loving staff and volunteers** from our Congregation for all worship services, Anchor Coffee House and Fine Arts Series events. All staff and volunteers who work with children are required to complete a background check.

WPC Sunday School

Children are encouraged to join our **high-energy engaging** Sunday School at 10:30 a.m. to delve into Bible stories further. All Sunday School classes meet in The Commons and are led to their classrooms by Shepherds. Preschool-aged children will explore what it means to be a child of God **through stories, songs, and interactive play**. They will return to The Commons at 11:15 a.m. to meet their families.

Wednesday Night Nursery

We welcome children from infants to preschool-aged into our Nursery during Wednesday night activities. It will be open from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m. They will be taken care of by loving and trained staff who will provide faith-based activities for preschool-age children.

Three-Year Old Bibles

A fun and colorful storybook Bible, "Spark Story Bible" is given to all children who are 3 years old by September of each year. These Bibles are great beginning Bibles for kids to explore the stories of the Bible in a meaningful way with their families. The Director of Christian Education partners with families to present these Bibles to our children in October of each year. Vacation Bible School (VBS)

Worship:

All are welcome in worship. Children are an essential part of the worshiping community at Westminster. They lead our worship service on the first Sunday of each month from October to May by reading liturgy, assisting the usher team in greeting congregants and collecting the offering.

Optional Kids' Worship

During the worship service, before the sermon, elementary age children are invited to come to Kids' Worship in the Chapel. Here they will learn about Bible stories through song, Scripture and dramatization. They will meet their families at the conclusion in The Commons. The first Sunday of the month kids will lead our traditional worship, allowing families to celebrate Communion together.

WPC Sunday School

Children are encouraged to join us Sunday mornings to delve into Bible stories further during Sunday School. Children will meet their Shepherd in The Commons at 10:30 a.m. Our volunteers will engage children in various workshops throughout the year, including technology, theatre, crafts, science, cooking, and more. Bitty Bells will be available for kids in Kindergarten to 2nd grade periodically during the program year. Kris DeWild will teach a special music rotation for all elementary kids periodically. Kids will perform in worship. Wednesday Kids' Club + Sunday Worship & Sunday School = Our whole program to raise kids to be 21st Century Disciples of Jesus Christ.

We use the entrance into third grade as a milestone to transition into reading the Bible by giving them a Spark Bible.
